

## Pre-K3 Supply List 2018-19

Dear Parents,

Welcome to San Jose Episcopal Day School! I am so excited about our Pre-K3 program and I am looking forward to getting to know you and your child. In order to prepare you for the school year, I would like to give you some details.

Each day your child will need to bring in 1-2 healthy snacks with one bottled water. Some suggestions are: crackers and cheese, fruit, jello, half a sandwich, goldfish, pretzels, cheese sticks, granola bars and chex mix.

To promote a positive, hassle-free end to each day, please have your child bring in a backpack that is big enough to carry home their arts and crafts at the end of the day/week.

Our Pre-K3 will not have a uniform for the school year; however, all children must dress in appropriate play clothes with tennis shoes. **On special days (picture day, Mother's Day, etc.) your child will need to wear a white collared shirt.** I will send a letter home about these special dates later in the year.

On "Meet Your Teacher Day," your child will need to bring the following supplies:

- An extra change of clothes in a Ziploc bag to keep in your child's cubby for any accidents that might occur. (shirt, shorts, socks, and underwear)
- 1 tray of Crayola washable watercolor paint set
- 1 box of large primary eight count Crayola crayons
- 2 six count packages of Elmer's glue sticks
- (1) 4 oz. bottle of Elmer's glue
- (1) 4 pack of Play Doh
- 2 boxes of tissues (Puffs or Kleenex)
- 2 large containers of Clorox wipes
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 container of wet wipes
- Boys: 1 box quart-sized Ziploc bags
- Girls: 1 box gallon-sized Ziploc bags

If you are ordering pre-packaged materials through the school, they will be in your child's classroom on Meet Your Teacher Day.

We look forward to an exciting year filled with fun and learning. Our program will allow your child to develop socially, intellectually, and emotionally. Please know that open communication between parent and teacher is essential for a positive year. We look forward to seeing you at "Meet Your Teacher Day."
