Suggestions for Rising Pre-K3 Students

1. Packing and unpacking backpack.
2. Zip and unzip lunch box.

6. Follow 1-2 commands, such as, "Get your snack, and sit down," or "Get a book, and look through it."
7. Read to your child every day.
