Classroom schedules will be distributed by teachers.

Teachers will continue to use Google/Seesaw as the learning management platforms.

Until COVID-19 precautions are lifted, the school prayer and pledge will be announced over the PA system. Once lifted the regular schedule will be resumed.

Attendance will be taken via Zoom or Google Meet

The schedule for *SJEDS at Home* students will be similar to students in the classroom. Teachers will provide schedules that will indicate the times students will need to Zoom in for synchronous learning. The schedules will also indicate time for asynchronous independent work and when they will not need to be on their devices. Students will have the opportunity to ask questions and interact with classmates. The schedule will also allow for time away from the computer for snacks, breaks, recess, etc. \*Changes can be expected as the teachers work through how best to meet the needs of all students.

Resource Classes













Initially, resource teachers will come to the classrooms to limit the movement of students around campus. As we work out traffic patterns and schedules, eventually some classes may go to the resource classrooms.

Initially, Mrs. Balek will come to the student classrooms to limit the movement of students on campus. She will have guidelines on how to safely check out books etc.

Social distancing practices will apply during lunch. Teachers are also encouraged to use outside areas for lunch. Time for additional sanitization procedures has been built into the lunch schedules.

Recess time will be limited to one group per area on the playground at a time. Time for sanitizing equipment has been built into the recess schedule. Creative games that encourage social distancing, such as pool noodle tag, will be encouraged.

Athletics will be conducted in accordance with NFISAC league guidelines. After School Activities will require non-SJEDS instructors to have temperature checks upon arrival. *All instructors and coaches will wear face coverings.* Health and safety policies and procedures followed by the school will be observed. Students will participate virtually.

SJEDS at Home students will be encouraged to checkout books and parents can make arrangements with Mrs. Balek by emailing her at kbalek@sjeds.org.

Students will eat lunch and rejoin the class at the scheduled time.

SJEDS at Home students will take a break from screen time during scheduled recess time. Outdoor play is encouraged.

*SJEDS at Home* students will not be permitted to participate in athletic and after school activities. When virtual students are comfortable returning to campus for school each day, they may join.
