

Pre-K3 Supply List 2021-2022

Dear Parents,

Welcome to San Jose Episcopal Day School! I am so excited about our Pre-K3 program, and I am looking forward to getting to know you and your child. In order to prepare you for the school year, I would like to give you some details.

Each day your child will need to bring in 1-2 healthy snacks with one bottled water. Some suggestions are: crackers and cheese, fruit, jello, half a sandwich, goldfish, pretzels, cheese sticks, granola bars, or Chex mix.

To promote a positive, hassle-free end to each day, please have your child bring in a backpack that is big enough to carry home their arts and crafts at the end of the day/week.

Our Pre-K3 will not have a uniform for the school year; however, your child may wear play clothes or have the option of wearing an SJEDS t-shirt with a khaki or navy skirt or shorts which can be purchased through the office. **All students are required to wear tennis shoes with socks.** On picture days your child will need to wear a white collared shirt with either khaki or navy skirt or shorts. I will send a letter home about these special dates later in the year.

On "Meet Your Teacher Day," your child will need to bring the following supplies:

- An extra change of clothes in a Ziploc bag to keep in your child's cubby for any accidents that might occur. (shirt, shorts, socks, shoes, and underwear)
- 1 tray of Crayola washable watercolor paint set
- 2 boxes of large primary eight-count Crayola crayons
- 1- 4 pack of Play-Doh
- 8 large Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 boxes of tissues (Puffs or Kleenex)
- 2 large containers of Clorox wipes
